## What is MHA?

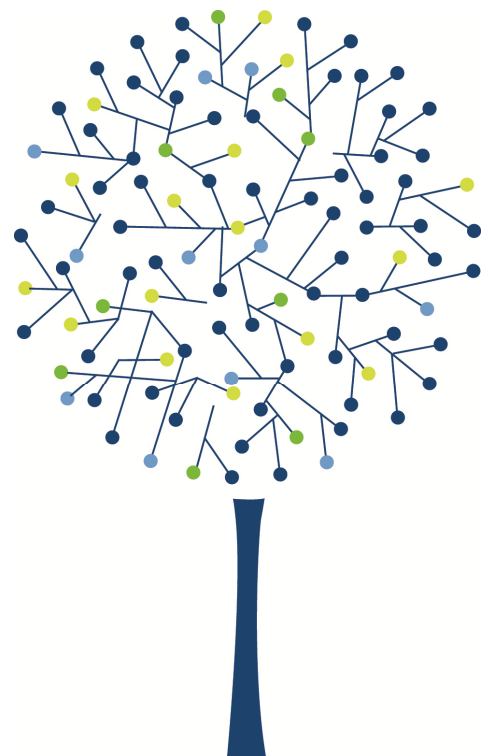
MHA is an invitation only UK wide association of progressive and respected accountancy and business advisory firms.
